

Preliminary Details for Chapter Council Meeting on June 6th 2009

I hope you're all enjoying your spring wherever your spring is happening. Our next Chapter Council meeting is June 6th 2009. Here are some of the logistical details that we know about the meeting, which is being hosted by the Tahoe Chapter near the shores of beautiful Lake Tahoe:

- First, we'll be meeting in Nevada...well, just barely, in Incline Village, NV right across the state line on the north shore of Lake Tahoe on the campus of Sierra Nevada College. This is approx. 34 miles from the Reno-Tahoe Airport, for those wanting to fly in. The drive is over the Mt. Rose Hwy., and takes about an hour.
- There are plenty of camping facilities within a picturesque 10 to 20 minute drive of the venue, and many motels/hotels in the area. See below for more details.
- The CC meeting is Saturday June 6th and will start around 8AM. There will be field trip opportunities in the area for Sunday morning...details to follow. (Note to those attending the Board meeting Friday night...it is in Tahoe City, about 20 minutes away from Incline Village).

Camping at lake level (6,225') at this time of year may be a little on the cool side at night, but should be tolerable. Average highs for the date are in the mid-60s, while lows are in the mid-30s.
